During the summer, the Friends test 2 sites in Page County along with 13 other sites downstream. We have spoken with the Luray Town Council and the Board of Supervisors seeking funding to expand the number of testing sites in Page. Community Works and the Friends of the Shenandoah River have developed a "Friends' Raiser" to raise awareness, volunteer support, and funds.
